

Application Shop Client – Reviewer’s Guide

Thank you for using Sony Ericsson’s Application Shop Client! This Reviewer’s Guide helps walk you through all the features the client offers. Please contact us at cs@handango.com for more detailed assistance.

1 Installation and Startup

1. Double click on the .SIS file or use My P800/P900 tools to open the file
 - .SIS files are the standard format for the P800 and P900
1. Follow the My P800/P900 software prompts to install the file to your phone
2. On your phone, select the Application Shop Client icon in your Applications list

2 Opening Screen



1. View Catalog – Displays the applications available for downloading
2. Update Catalog – Connects to the Internet and updates the catalog with the latest software offering
3. Downloaded Files – Provides access to all your downloaded applications
4. Account Information – Allows you to store and protect billing information
5. Info – Shows version and basic information about the Application Shop Client
6. Exit – Returns you to your P800/P900 Applications menu
7. Help file – Offers similar information to this Reviewer’s Guide

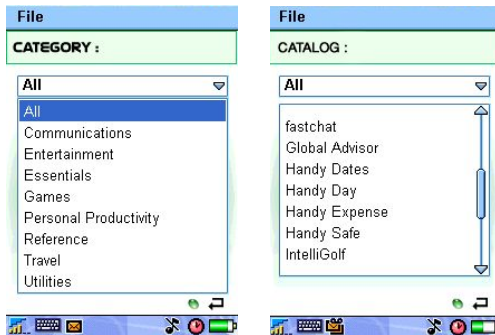
3 Account Information

1. Select “ACCOUNT INFORMATION” from the home screen.
2. Enter the requested information.
 - Enter address information on Step 1
 - Enter a unique password on Step 2
 - Enter name and billing information on Step 2
3. Select your currency on Step 2 – this will determine what currency you see when viewing application descriptions.
4. Click “OK” when finished to save your information.
5. Revisit the Account Information page to modify or view your information at any time.

Enter your address on Step 1 and then select the Step 2 tab on the bottom to continue. Create a password and enter your billing information to finish setting up your account.

4 View Catalog

1. Use the stylus to select "VIEW CATALOG" from the home screen.
2. View subcategories of applications by using the drop down list.
 - All applications are shown as the default
3. To view an application, simply use the stylus to tap on the application name.



View different subcategories of applications by using the Category selection tool. Click on an application to view details regarding it.

4.1 Viewing, Downloading and Installing Applications

1. Select an application's name to view details regarding that title
 - Each application has the price in US Dollars, the average rating from past customers and a short description.
 - Click the "Screenshot" tab at the bottom of the screen to see a specific picture of the application
2. To download an application, click "Try" to commence an Internet connection.
 - Wireless data service is required.
3. Choose your service from the drop-down box titled "Account Name:"
4. Click "CONNECT" to continue
 - The status of your wireless connection will be provided in the middle of the screen
5. The download will commence automatically.
 - If the download is halted – by the phone, your service provider or by clicking "Stop" – you will be able to restart the download where you left off without losing any data by clicking "Try" for that application again.
6. After the download is complete, a red check mark will appear next to the file name.
7. Use the "back" function to return to the home screen
8. Select "DOWNLOADED FILES" from the home screen.
9. Click on a specific application.
 - To install a downloaded file, select the file name and click "Install."
10. Choose a location to install the application
 - View and accept the User Agreement if necessary
 - Installation will begin automatically.
11. Find your new applications in the P800/P900 Applications menu and enjoy!

4.2 Buying Applications

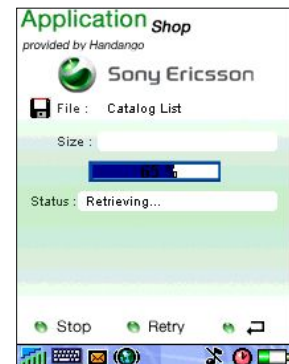
1. Select the application you wish to purchase.
2. Click "BUY" from the menu at the bottom of the screen.
3. Enter your password.
 - If you have not created an account, you will need to enter the necessary information



4. Choose your service from the drop-down box titled "Account Name:"
5. Click "CONNECT" to continue
 - The status of your wireless connection will be provided in the middle of the screen
6. Once your purchase has been processed, you will receive a message with your activation code.
 - This will also be sent to the email address you entered for your account information.
7. The download will begin automatically.
8. After the download is complete, a red check mark will appear next to the file name.
9. Use the "back" function to return to the home screen
10. Select "DOWNLOADED FILES" from the home screen.
11. Click on a specific application.
 - To install a downloaded file, select the file name and click "Install."
12. Choose a location to install the application
 - View and accept the User Agreement if necessary
 - Installation will begin automatically.
13. Find your new applications in the P800/P900 Applications menu.
14. Enter your activation code following the application's directions and enjoy!

5 Update Catalog

1. Select "UPDATE CATALOG" from the home screen.
 - This will commence an Internet connection. Wireless data service is required.
2. Choose your service from the drop-down box and click "CONNECT."
3. The Application Shop Client will check for new applications and download them automatically.
 - If you are using the most current application list, you will be notified.
4. The client will also check to see if there is a new version of the Application Shop Client software available. If there is, you will be given the option to download and install it at your discretion.
5. View the updated catalog by clicking "View Catalog" on the home screen.



The Application Shop Client will check for the latest adds.

6 Downloaded Files



Select an app from the list to install or delete it.

1. Select "DOWNLOADED FILES" from the home screen.
2. Click on a specific application.
 - To install a downloaded file, select the file name and click "Install."
 - To delete a file, select the file name and click "Remove." Confirm by clicking "OK".
3. Previously installed files can be access from the main applications screen on your P800 or P900.
